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What is prayer?



Prayer is my single greatest opportunity to communicate with & have the undivided attention of the Creator of the world.

The dilemma: If God already knows everything that I need and He already knows every request I will bring to Him, why pray?

1. When I pray, I express trust in God.

I say when I pray:

God, I believe in You.

God, I believe in Your ability.

God, I believe in Your desire to work all things for Your glory and for my

good.

Scripture does not say:

Trust God can.

Scripture does say:

Trust God will!

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to His purpose.

Romans 8:28

2. When I pray, I experience the delight of God.

Psalm 147:11:

The Lord delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love.



3. When I pray, I expect answers from God.

If I do not expect to hear from God, I will not hear from God.

Matthew 21:22:

If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.

God desires I pray expecting Him to both hear and answer my prayers.

Mark 11:24:

Therefore, I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe you have received it, and it will be yours.

The key to expecting God to answer = A desire and a passion for a deeper experience with God.

A robust prayer life for Donelson First begins with a desire and a passion within each of us for a deeper experience with God.

3 Mistakes I make when I pray...

Mistake #1: I don't ask God how to pray.

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Jeremiah 29:11

KNOW (HEBREW) = INTIMACY, INCLUDING SEXUAL RELATIONS, IN RELATIONSHIPS

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Ephesians 2:10

God already has the plans for my life. My prayer life should hinge upon Him leading my prayers so that I follow the plans He already has prepared for me.

Mistake #2: I don't ask God for "big" when I pray.

I am the Lord your God, who brought you up out of Egypt. Open wide your mouth and I will fill it.

Psalm 81:10



Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us. Ephesians 3:20

What immeasurably more have I missed by not asking "big" of God?

Mistake #3: I don't expect God to answer all I pray.

My trust in God is often defined by my experience with God.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6

UNDERSTANDING (HEBREW) =
GOOD SENSE
AND CLEVERNESS

My trust should be less about my experiences and more about God's promises.

Therefore, I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

Mark 11:24

HAVE I MADE A MISTAKE

This should be my aspiration:

To have a prayer life with the Lord more intimate than any other relationship in my life.

Mistake #4: I don't pray when I should pray.

Because he turns his ear to me, I will call on him as long as I live. Psalm 116:2

Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Psalm 23:4

DARKNESS (HEBREW) = GLOOM; THE DARKEST OF GLOOM

The Way to Pray When I Don't Feel Like Praying

1. Acknowledge.

Life is hard and tough and difficult and broken and depleting and frustrating and hurtful and sometimes demoralizing and sad and full of trouble.



One thing I have to be careful of is believing a false, but often deeply held belief:

If I love, serve, and obey the Lord, I will be immune to suffering.

As a mature and focused person of prayer, I must acknowledge: Troubles are inevitable.

My troubles should inspire in me an even greater depth of prayer.

2. Invite.

When I invite God's Word into my story, I receive His comfort even in the midst of my valley of darkness.

3. Listen.

When was the last time I began my prayer time listening rather than talking?

I can't welcome God's lead if I am the one doing all the talking.

The Lord confides in those who fear him; he makes his covenant known to them. Psalm 25:14

The Lord confides in me when I choose to listen to Him.

PRAYER

GOD, AS I AM QUIET, HELP ME TO HEAR YOUR VOICE AND TO DO WHAT YOU ASK.



Imagine if the Church became truly focused, intentional, and determined to pray God's will above her wants.

Imagine if I became truly prayerful to die to my wants and pursue God's will above all.

This is really a shift in the way I pray – a shift away from a list of "to-dos" and an intentional plea for God's will to be accomplished through my life.

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us - whatever we ask - we know that we have what we asked of him. 1 John 5:14-15

What does it mean to pray God's "will be done?"

I should pray less about what I want and more about what God wills.

The Way to Pray: God's Will Over My Wants

1. Ask.

"God, show me your will."

A church led by God will be inspired by a pastor desiring to be led by God.

2. Give.

When I am ungrateful, when I complain, and when I speak negatively, I am not in God's will!

... give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

3. Follow.

Do I follow the Word?

Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. Psalm 119:105

To follow God's Word is to discover God's will.

Consistency in the Word will produce clarity in God's will.

If I am asking God to show me His will, and if I am thankful in the circumstances of my life, and if I am actively following the pattern of Scripture in my life, I will know the will of God for my life.



4. Obey.

A huge part of living obediently is in coming clean when I don't live obediently.

If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened.

Psalm 66:16

And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. Matthew 6:12-13

PASSAGES

MATTHEW 26:39 MATTHEW 6:9-10 ISAIAH 55:10-11 1 PETER 3:12 JAMES 4:3-4 HEBREWS 12:14B ISAIAH 40:31

If God only answered the prayers of sinless people, there would never be any answered prayers.

The pursuit of holiness leads to a consistent life of obedience.

I cannot consistently know God's will if I am willfully disobeying God's ways.

5. Wait.

HOPE (HEBREW) = WAIT WITH EXPECTATION; WAIT WITH TRUST

Go back to the last thing God told me to do and stay the course until I hear otherwise.

PRAYER

TEACH ME HOW TO ASK, GIVE, FOLLOW, OBEY & WAIT AS I PRAY GOD'S WILL OVER MY WANTS.
